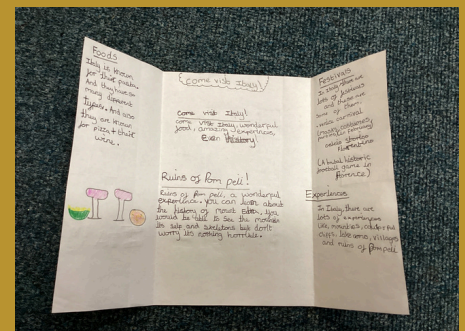
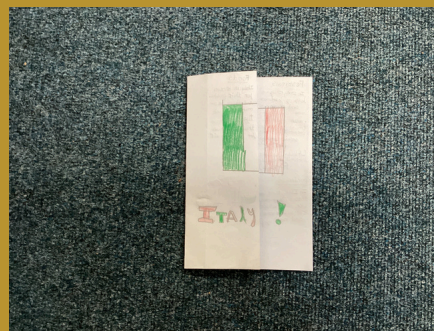
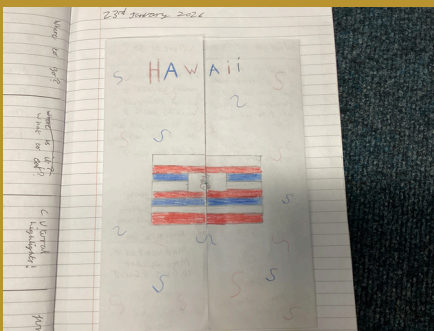
Pancake Making

Emperors have continued learning about natural disasters, this has been our focus for both Geography and English. The children have learnt about the Pacific Ring of Fire, comparing earthquakes that had struck both Haiti and Japan. The children researched the impact of the disasters and the recovery, which was affected by economic and social aspects of the countries. They also made a travel brochure to persuade visitors to visit their islands. These were then sent to an external educational travel agent for critique, we are awaiting their feedback.
