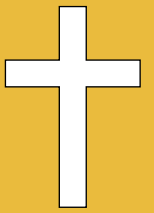

In Collective Worship we thought about how Jesus was a refugee, and the importance of showing love to all.

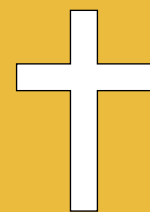

Vacancy for Clerk to School Governing Body

Lockerley Primary School Board of Governors are seeking to appoint an efficient and enthusiastic Clerk, with strong organisation skills and administrative experience to support our school governing body. You will work closely with the Chair of Governors and Headteacher to co-ordinate the running of Full Governing Body meetings. The role will include agenda setting, coordinating communication and documentation, minute taking, advising on practice and policy with reference to national frameworks and guidance. Responsibilities also include liaising with the Chair of Governors and Headteacher with regards to compliance.

The successful candidate will be able to work under their own initiative, manage deadlines and keep accurate records. Essential to this role is the ability to maintain confidentiality. The role requires attendance at evening meetings with home working for the remainder of the time. Access to a computer and internet is required. The main requirement of the role is to attend eleven meetings per year. The post needs 5 hours per meeting to include preparation, attendance and write up of minutes. Hourly Rate is: £14.40 per hour, the position is term time only.

- Walk with your child and discuss potential hazards such as driveways, junctions, parked cars and bends
- Work out together the safest route even if this involves a slightly longer journey
- Let your child suggest places to cross and discuss their choice
- Practice the green cross code on your way to and from school - reminding them to stop, look, listen and think

I don't have time to walk!

- Park the car some way from the school gates and walk the last part of the journey

- Try to find time to walk with them once during the week
- Your child will qualify for a certificate if either option is taken

- The chance to teach important road safety skills
