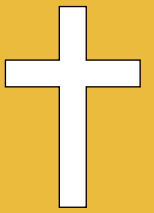

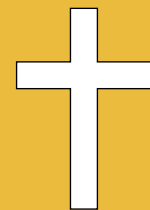
In Collective Worship we thought about the importance of community, and how Jesus created a respectful community with his disciples
