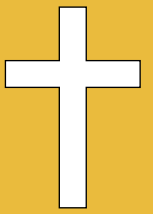

House Captains

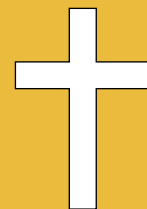
